

3 Keys to Cold Weather Comfort



Water

Improperly managed water lines can increase house moisture by over 20%!

- Moisture increases ammonia production
- Clean lines regularly
- Maintain appropriate line height and pressure



Warmth

Birds thermoregulate and use their energy to grow when their environment is warm.

- Heated litter releases moisture
- Improper burning releases carbon monoxide
- Ensure heaters function properly



Ventilation

Minimum ventilation removes moisture and ammonia and replenishes oxygen levels in the house.

- Balance fresh air intake with conserving heat
- Warm air along the ceiling to avoid drafts the cause wet floors and uncomfortable birds
